Activities

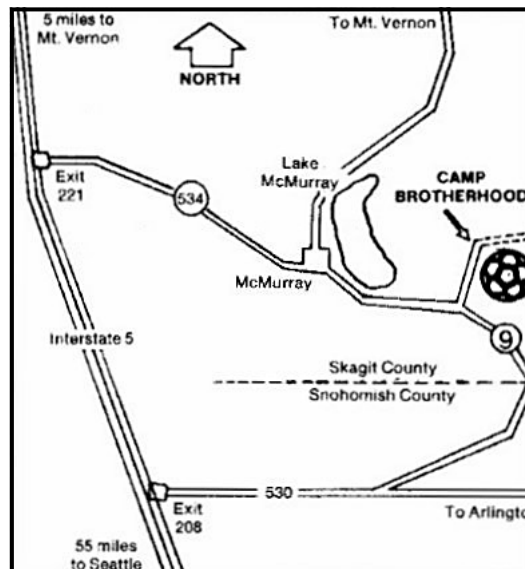
